For each additional page (above 4 pages), an extra fee of €20 will be charged. Authors presenting more than 2 papers have to pay an additional full registration fee.

SUBMISSION

The final version of a paper must be 4-6 pages and be prepared according to the following guidelines (IEEE Proceedings Format) in DOC or DOCX formats (in English only). An extra fee of EUR 20 will be charged for each additional page above 4 pages.

The paper should be submitted using Microsoft CMT. The paper template with instructions on submission is available on the Conference Web Page.

The paper should define the scope of the paper, emphasize new advances, theories and/or applications and include an analysis of results.

Accepted papers will be submitted for inclusion into IEEE Xplore subject to meeting IEEE Xplore's scope and quality requirements. The Conference Proceedings will be published with ISSN and ISBN numbers.

Best of presented papers on the Conference will be recommended in extended article for publication in a special issue of the "[Bavarian Journal of Applied Sciences](#)" and journal "[Advances in Cyber-Physical Systems](#)".
