SUBMISSION

The final version of a paper must be 4-6 pages and be prepared according to the following guidelines (IEEE Proceedings Format) in DOC or DOCX formats (in English only). An extra fee of EUR 20 will be charged for each additional page above 4 pages.

The paper should be submitted using [Microsoft CMT](#). The paper template with instructions on submission is available on the Conference Web Page.

The paper should define the scope of the paper, emphasize new advances, theories and/or applications and include an analysis of results.

All accepted papers will be submitted for indexing in the IEEE Xplore Digital Library and other indexing database (Scopus, Google Scholar, CiteSeerX, etc.).

Best of presented papers on the Conference will be recommended in extended article for publication in a special issue of the "[Bavarian Journal of Applied Sciences](#)" and journal "[Advances in Cyber-Physical Systems](#)".

ABOUT DEGGENDORF

Deggendorf is a town in Bavaria, Germany, capital of the Deggendorf district.

Deggendorf lies at the western foot of the Bavarian and Bohemian forests, east of Straubing. Founded about 750, it passed to the dukes of Bavaria in 1242 and was chartered in 1316. The river and the forested mountains form a picturesque setting for the city, which retains its medieval pattern and parts of its fortifications. Deggendorf is a market centre with a harbour on the Danube, and it has become an important regional tourist centre. The city is the site of a university of applied sciences. Notable buildings in the city include the town hall, the Baroque parish church, and the Heilige Grab Church, built in atonement for a violation of the consecrated Host and the scene of an annual pilgrimage. The history museum has notable archaeological displays.
